A MCOM G-2 supports the AMCOM Command Group and Staff, Program Executive Office (PEO) Missiles and Space, PEO Aviation and several other U.S. Army programs located in the Redstone Arsenal area that are affiliated with other PEOs (PEO Soldier, PEO IEWS).

A MCOM G-2 provides the Command indication and warning (situational awareness) of world events that have the potential to result in deployment of U.S. Army Aviation and Missile assets or harm to assets (personnel, facilities and equipment) already deployed. AMCOM G-2 also provides support to legacy and developing army missile and aviation technologies in the areas of threat, targets and parallel technology development. Additionally, AMCOM ensures the safeguarding of classified and sensitive information and materiel through multidiscipline security support (information security, personnel security, industrial security, and foreign disclosure). This support allows AMCOM to be prepared at all times to respond to Warfighter requirements.
