2. Determine the magnitude of deficiencies and seek the root causes of problem areas.
3. Teach systems, processes and procedures.
4. Share innovative ideas and best practices.

1. Requests for information in regards to workplace issues.
2. Requests for assistance on solving issues related to the workplace.
