## Office of Small Business Programs (OSBP)

**M**ission: To ensure effective implementation of the programs assigned to the OSBP. These programs are Small Business (SB), Small Disadvantaged Businesses (SDB), 8(a), Women-Owned Small Business (WOSB), Historically Underutilized Business Zone (HUBZone), Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business (SDVOSB), Veteran-Owned Small Business (VOSB), Historically Black Colleges and Universities and Minority Service Institutions (HBCU/MSIs), AbilityOne (formally NIB/NISH), and Federal Prison Industries (FPI) programs.

**O**SBP serves as the principal advisor to the commander and Team Redstone regarding small business issues and assists all businesses on government contracting matters, including changes to the procurement system.



**I**n addition to supporting the U.S. Army Aviation and Missile Command, the OSBP also serves as an advocate for small business firms and acts as the liaison with the Small Business Administration (SBA), providing small businesses technical advisory support to the SBA Procurement Center Representatives. The OSBP monitors small business performance goals and regularly reports program accomplishments and performance results to the AMCOM Command Group and Army Materiel Command Office of Small Business Programs.
