- The SAM combines federal procurement systems and the Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance into one new system that replaces and consolidates Central Contractor Registry (CCR), Federal Agency Registration (Fedreg), Online Representations and Certifications Application (ORCA), and Excluded Parties List System (EPLS).
