## Safety Office

**M**ission: The Safety Office serves as a principal independent staff advisor to the AMCOM Commander in all matters relating to the safety of people and equipment provided to aviation and missile customers by this Life Cycle Management Command. We are organized into 3 divisions (Missile System Safety, Aviation System Safety, and Operational Safety) consistent with the commodities and facilities managed by AMCOM.



**V**ision: To support aviation and missile weapon system readiness by optimizing the safety of equipment and personnel in response to evolving threats, both to the army and joint forces.



**T**he AMCOM Safety Office manages the RSA Explosive Safety Mission across 14 tenants with widely diverse research, development and test operations. The goal is to protect personnel and facilities through compliance with DoD/Army Explosive Safety standards and mitigation of risks in explosive storage and disposal of obsolete/aging munitions.

The occupational safety and risk management programs are regularly inspected and monitored to ensure compliance with laws and regulations needed to protect the workforce, equipment and facilities.

**F**or equipment in the sustainment life cycle phase, we analyze aviation and missile improvement plans and designs for opportunities to enhance system safety by working closely with commodity program and product managers.

The AMCOM safety and maintenance message process is without peer; we provide immediate, targeted notification of hazards and corrective actions needed to restore safe operation and readiness of equipment needed by aviators and troops worldwide.
